

Important Cleaning & Maintenance Guidelines

To preserve the appearance and performance of your panels, do not use abrasive materials, aggressive chemicals, or strong solvents. Improper cleaning methods may cause permanent surface damage, dulling, or discoloration and may void warranty coverage.

Do NOT Use the Following:

X Acidic cleaners

Examples: vinegar, rust removers, lime-scale or calcium removers

X Alkaline cleaners

Examples: bleach, oven cleaners, baking soda-based cleaners

X Ammonia-based cleaners

Examples: window and glass cleaners containing ammonia

X Strong solvents

Examples: acetone, isopropyl alcohol (IPA), denatured alcohol, methylated spirits

X Abrasive cleaners or tools

Examples: scouring pads, steel wool, abrasive sponges, or gritty cream cleaners

X Specialty ABS edge banding cleaners

Recommended Cleaning Procedure

1. Immediately wipe up spills using a clean, soft, non-abrasive cloth.
2. For routine cleaning, use warm water and a microfiber cloth.
3. For heavier soil, add a small amount of mild dishwashing detergent to warm water and gently wipe the surface.
4. Always test new cleaning products on an inconspicuous area prior to general use.
5. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen a microfiber cloth with odorless mineral spirits and gently wipe. (Do not flood the surface and use sparingly.)
6. Repeat cleaning as required until the surface is clean.
7. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly using a soft, lint-free cloth to prevent streaking or residue.
